- 4. Include reshoot & cancellation policies Ensure your invoice reflects any applicable fees.
- 5. Double-check details before sending Verify client information, total charges, and payment terms before finalizing the invoice.

Using this checklist helps streamline billing, maintain clarity with clients, and maximize your earnings.
